

The Club Vista HOA Assigned Parking Permit Application

The Rules and Regulations of The Club Vista HOA specifically require residents to park vehicles in their garages and/or carports.

Before a space is assigned to a Vista resident it must be determined that two vehicles are being parked in the residents' garage and/or carport. To ensure that garages and/or carports are not being used for storage or any other purpose that prevents vehicle parking, the Vista Committee reserves the right to inspect residents' garage and/or carport before assigning a parking space. **FIRST STEP: Give Vista Committee this completed application. SECOND STEP: A garage inspection will be scheduled.**

Assigned parking spaces are issued for a minimum of three months at \$105.00 or a maximum six-month term at \$210.00; if early termination, NO refunds will be awarded. The billing will be sent to the property owner on record along with their monthly assessment. An assigned parking space may not be reserved for more than 6 months at a time.

Renewal of an assigned parking space is not automatic and the Vista Committee reserves the right to terminate use of an assigned space at any time if it is determined that the aforementioned criteria are not met.

Parking permits/placards must be displayed on the vehicle parked in the Assigned Space at all times or risk being towed at the owners expense.
